




- You may NOT be registered in the same course off campus and at Poppy

Secondary School Apprenticeship Program

- □ \$1000.00 Scholarship (with C+ or better GPA)
- 8 grade 11 credits = 240 hours... can be paid work.
 8 grade 12 credits = 240 hours... can be paid work.
- □ There are currently over 120 apprenticeable SSA trades in B.C.
- Students may apprentice outside of school time or a blend of school and work. (Secondary School Apprenticeship)

- LANGARA... offers a guaranteed placement at Law School in Sussex U in England. Complete 60 credits at Langara 3.1 GPA
- KWANTLEN ... offers the first year of engineering and it is directly transferable to UBC's second year of engineering.



- Students must attach a statement from a coach/community teacher indicating achievement in a sport or fine arts area.
- Student must have displayed satisfactory qualities of attendance, punctuality, initiative, and co-operation.

The school scholarship committee will make final selection.



 - Awards
 - Experience
- 2. Organization
 - ✓ Database
 - ✓ Volunteer
- 3. Follow through ... DO THE WORK !
 - □ Complete applicationESSAY



Remember:

- The first scholarship you apply for is the most difficult...then you can cut and paste the organized information.
- Start early then you have time to edit.
- Do not be discouraged if you do not have a 90% GPA, some scholarships consider athletics, volunteer work and part-time work. Some scholarships are affiliated scholarships.
- Fit your answer to the question.
- Use active verbs.
- Provide details about what you actually did.
- Always check your spelling.
- Use black ink.
- Do not use liquid paper.





- 1. Make a list of all available scholarships. START close to home... parent's employer / bank / student's part time employer
- 2. Identify 'guaranteed' scholarships.
- 3. Meet the application deadlines.
- 4. Neatness matters.
- 5. Avoid emailing or faxing your application.
- 6. Focus on quality rather than quantity.
- 7. Help your references.
- 8. Help yourself.
- 9. Keep a hard copy.
- 10. Know what they are looking for.



Remember the basics .

- ✓ Fit your answer to the scholarship criteria
- ✓ Use active verbs (see hand out)
- ✓ Provide details of what you actually did
- Always check your spelling and punctuation (find an English teacher to edit)
- ✓ Use black ink...unless they ask for blue
- ✓ Do not use liquid paper
